


The Key: Using Mortgage Brain and the Mortgage Trading Exchange (mte) with the Key


This function will allow you to transfer a single client and mortgage details into Mortgage Brain and **mte**.

Firstly, ensure that Mortgage Brain is set-up. Go to **Set up**, then **Integration links**. Click **Auto Configure** for the system to search for the installed Mortgage Brain system.




Export

If the system has detected that Mortgage Brain or **mte** is installed then the software link buttons will be available.




Using mte
